EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 70

**AN ORDER EXTENDING THE EFFECTIVITY OF EXECUTIVE
ORDER NO. 56 UNTIL JUNE 30, 2021**

WHEREAS, the World Health Organization (WHO) has declared a COVID-19 pandemic;

WHEREAS, President Rodrigo Duterte issued Presidential Proclamation 1021 extending the State of Calamity in the country until September 12, 2021;

WHEREAS, there is a need to control the COVID-19 cases in Davao City because of the full occupancy of the COVID-19 beds in the Southern Philippines Medical Center (SPMC) and the Temporary Treatment and Monitoring Facilities (TTMFs);

WHEREAS, an order providing for the adoption of Other Alternative Work Arrangements (OAWA) in public and private offices was implemented as provided in Executive Order No. 56 s. 2020 to avoid the lockdown of government and business offices and to ensure that overcrowding, mass gathering and socialization are continuously prohibited;

WHEREAS, it becomes necessary to extend Executive Order No. 56 s. 2020 to continuously avoid a close contact scenario for all employees and to decongest passengers of public utility vehicles throughout the day to lessen the risk of transmission.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, SARA Z. DUTERTE, Mayor of the City of Davao, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order the following:

SECTION 1. OTHER ALTERNATIVE WORK ARRANGEMENTS. Executive Order No. 56 s. 2020 is hereby reiterated and its effectivity is extended until June 30, 2021.

SECTION 2. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. If any provision of this Executive Order is declared invalid or unconstitutional, the other provisions not affected thereby shall remain valid and subsisting.

SECTION 3. REPEALING CLAUSE. All orders or parts thereof which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Executive Order are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVITY. This Order shall take effect from December 31, 2020 to June 30, 2021.
