## **EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 65-A**

Series of 2020

## AN ORDER CONSOLIDATING ALL THE ISSUANCES ON THE USE OF FACE SHIELDS

**WHEREAS,** the World Health Organization (WHO) has declared a COVID-19 pandemic;

**WHEREAS,** President Rodrigo Duterte issued Presidential Proclamation 1021 extending the State of Calamity in the country until September 12, 2021;

**WHEREAS,** there is a need to create a guide for Davao City residents where the use of face shield is mandatory and its basis;

**NOW, THEREFORE, I, SARA Z. DUTERTE,** Mayor of the City of Davao, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order the following:

**SECTION 1. MANDATORY.** The following are the issuances that make face shield mandatory in certain areas:

- A. Department of Transportation (DOTr) Memorandum Circular No. 2020-014 dated August 3, 2020, mandates the mandatory wearing of face shield with a face mask for all passengers in areas where public transportation is allowed;
- B. Department of Trade and Industry (DTI) and Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE) Joint Memorandum Circular No. 20-04-A dated August 15, 2020, which shall apply to all private establishments regardless of economic activity including economic zones, mandates the use of face shield with a face mask with the following guide:
  - II. Workplace Safety and Health
  - B. Reducing Transmission of COVID-19
    - b. Face shields
      - i. Face shields shall cover the entire face (completely cover the sides and length of the face). If possible, face shields should extend to the ears and below the chin.
      - ii. Visor-type face shields shall not be allowed.
    - iii. Face shields and masks should always be worn together when interacting with colleagues, clients, and/or visitors.
    - iv. Face shields may be removed according to the demands of the work or when the occupational safety and health of the employees so requires. (i.e., working near a fire or in the kitchen, operating a machine, etc.)



- C. Inter-Agency Task Force (IATF) Resolution No. 68, s. 2020 dated September 3, 2020, mandates the use of a face shield with a face mask in the following places: supermarkets, public markets, malls, and in venues where government-initiated meetings and critical government services are being conducted or provided.
- D. Davao City Police Office (DCPO) and all its camps and police stations for all the guests accessing all police services.
- E. All City Government offices shall require their employees and clients/visitors to wear a face shield and face mask inside their buildings and rooms.

**SECTION 2. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE.** If any provision of this Executive Order is declared invalid or unconstitutional, the other provisions not affected thereby shall remain valid and subsisting.

**SECTION 3. REPEALING CLAUSE.** All Orders or parts thereof which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Executive Order are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

**SECTION 4. EFFECTIVITY.** This Order shall take effect immediately.
